

About:

The Glam Gizmo is a serialised audio drama swirling in science fiction, eccentricity with a dash of horror.

Episode 1 Season 1 follows the story of Max, a reluctant young man trying to escape debt and paving through the monotony of being a kitchen hand, but his life swings out of proportion when Boltizor (a man with reptile characteristics) tracks him down and tries to use him in his latest evil scheme.

Moments later, he meets Professor Paradox, a strange cosmic adventurer who tasks him and his friend Lucy to defeat Boltizor and return Melbourne to order.

Following through the season, we meet a diverse cast who make up the ensemble that are placed in the Professor's bookshop on Celestial Avenue; where they meet and use their wits to fight monsters and villains on a regular basis.

Season 2 sees the ripple effects caused by the Clockmaker, a dark magician who can alter people's personal timelines and how it changes everybody's very nature, even the closest of friends.

In Season 3, the hunt is on for a powerful artifact called the Resurrection Blade, a conscious device that has the power to bring back the dead - But who will it be used for and for what cause?

And in Season 4, a terrifying alien race called the Catharo are slowly eating away at reality creating serious trouble for the universe, but when politician John Hawkspur is petitioning for alien migration in Australia, the doomsday clock begins to tick faster.

Production:

The Glam Gizmo started production in 2019 incubated through SYN Media's podcast network.

In 2022, it was obtained by series creator Tom Denham and has since been produced independently.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, the podcast has and since is recorded remotely using online means such as Zoom to make direction possible.
